Instrument Care Reminders

Before putting your instrument back in its case after playing, do the following:


- Remove the reed, wipe off excess moisture and return it to the reed case.
- Remove the mouthpiece and wipe the inside with a clean cloth. Once a week, wash the mouthpiece with warm tap water. Dry thoroughly.
- Remove the neck and shake out excess moisture.
 Dry with neck cleaner.
- Drop the weight of the chamois or cotton swab into the bell. Pull the swab through the body several times. Return the instrument to its case.
- Your case is designed to hold only specific objects.
 If you try to force anything else into the case,
 it may damage your instrument.
